Competencies Proficiency Scale



Level 5 - Expert: You are known as an expert in this area. You can provide guidance, troubleshoot and answer questions related to this area of expertise and the field where the skill is used. (90-100%)

Level 4 - Advanced: You can perform the actions associated with this skill without assistance. (80-89%)

Level 3 - Intermediate: You are able to successfully complete tasks in this competency as requested. Help from an expert may be required from time to time, but you can usually perform the skill independently. (70-79%)

Level 2 - Novice: You have the level of experience gained in a classroom and/or experimental scenarios or as a trainee on-the-job. You are expected to need help when performing this skill. (60-69%)

Level 1 - Basic: You have a common knowledge or an understanding of basic techniques and concepts. (50-59%)
